

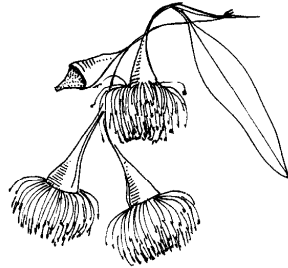

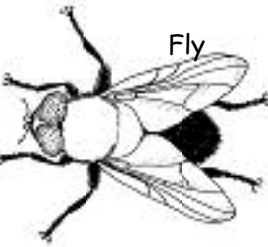
- 🌸 Nests are full of baby birds of all types

- 🌸 Sydney Red Gum attracts Bogong moths



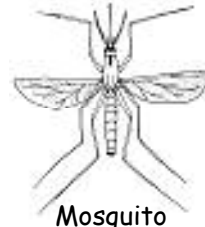

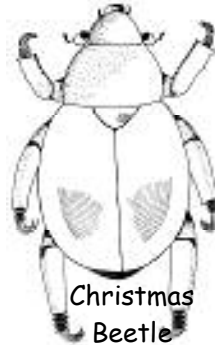

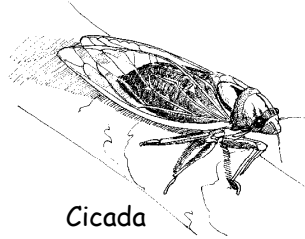

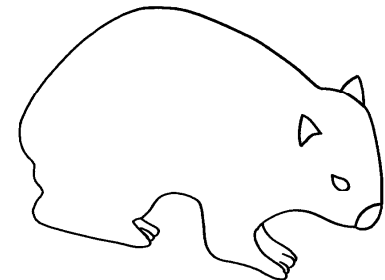


Wren

- 🌸 Humans are everywhere!



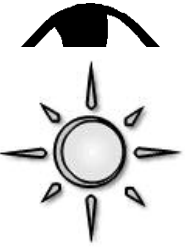

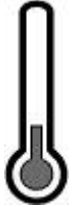
