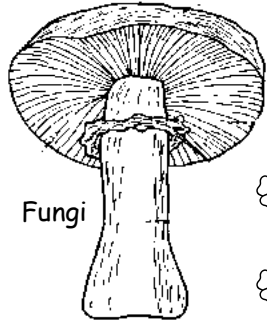

Fungi are everywhere



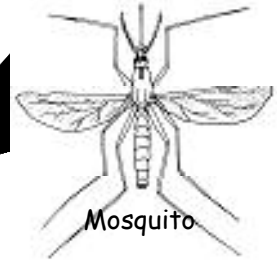
Female Lyrebirds lay their one egg



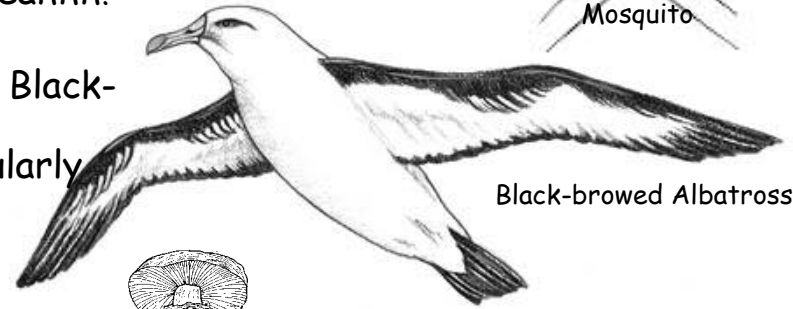
Snakes hibernate because the nights are getting colder



Bream head up the creek to lay their eggs



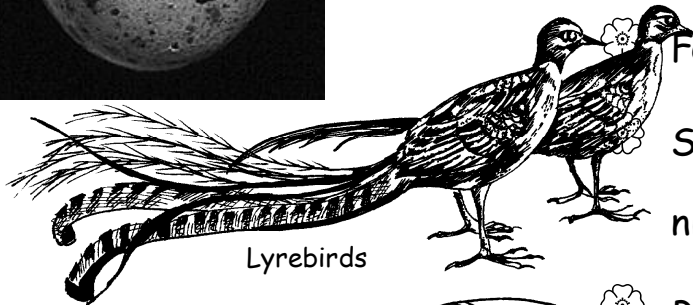
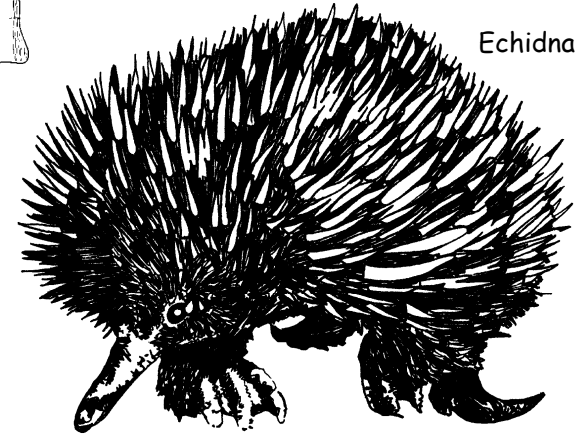
