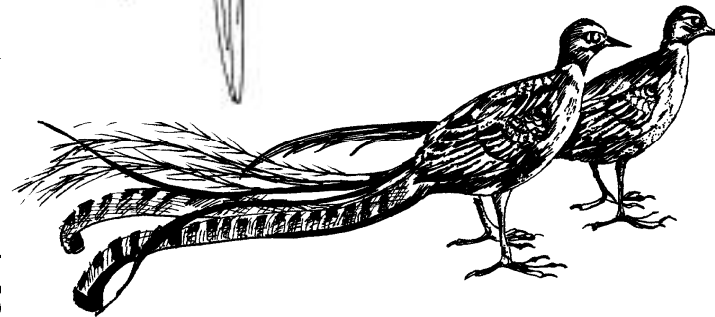

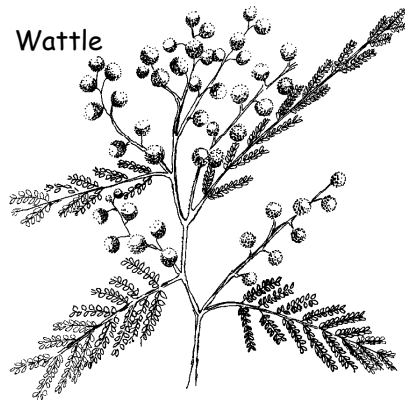


☺ Grass Trees (Xanthorrhoea) are in flower. The Honey Eaters, Friarbirds and insects all enjoy the oozing nectar

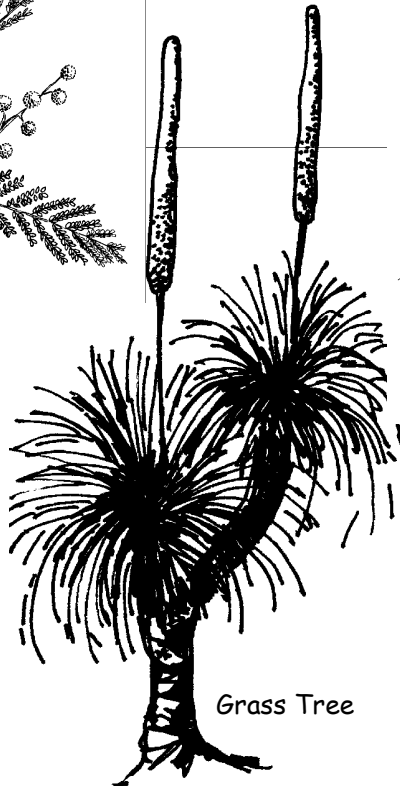
☺ The Sunshine Wattle, *Acacia terminalis* is in bloom. Butterflies and bugs are attracted to the plant.

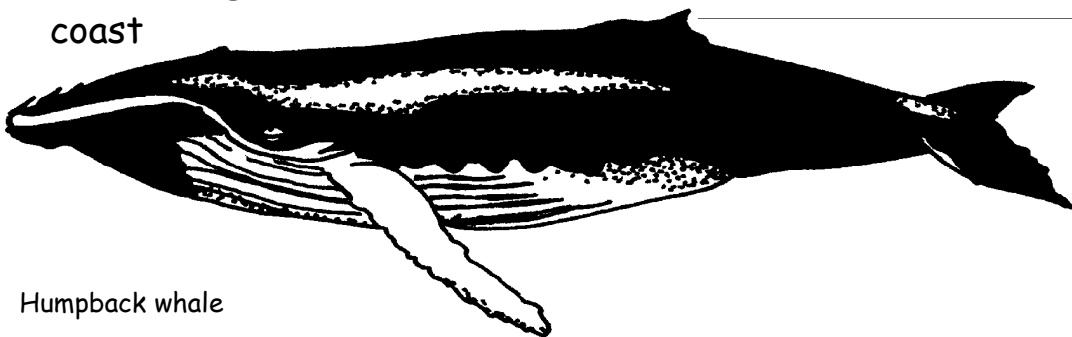


Grass Tree

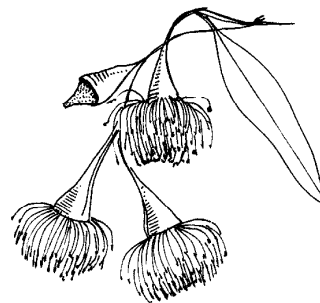
☺ The male Superb Lyrebirds are calling loudly from on top of their display mounds
