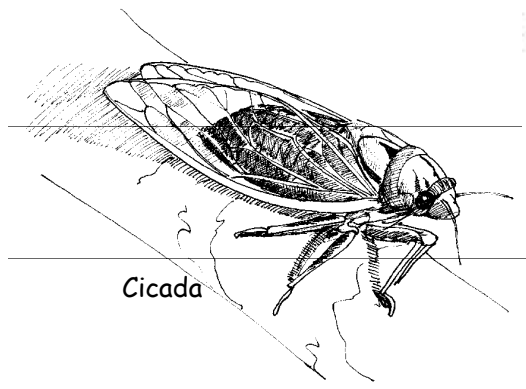
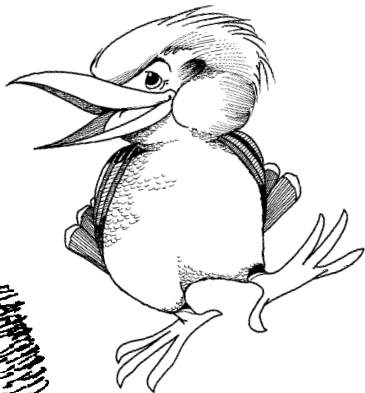


Southern Cross

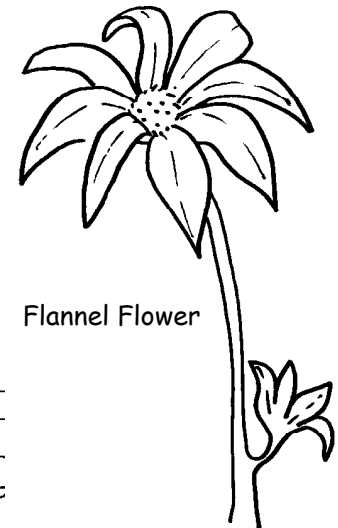
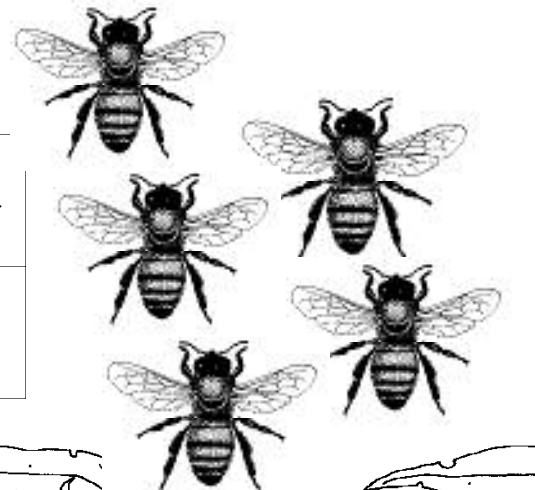


- \* Mud crabs and Blue swimmer crabs are mating

- \* Cicadas emerge from underground and leave their pupa cases on tree trunks

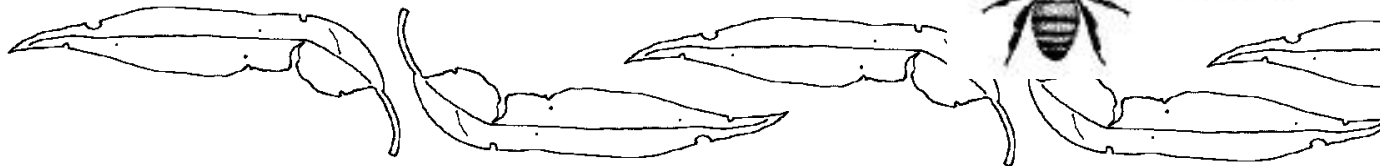
- \* Snakes and skinks are active

- \* The best time for looking for ground orchids



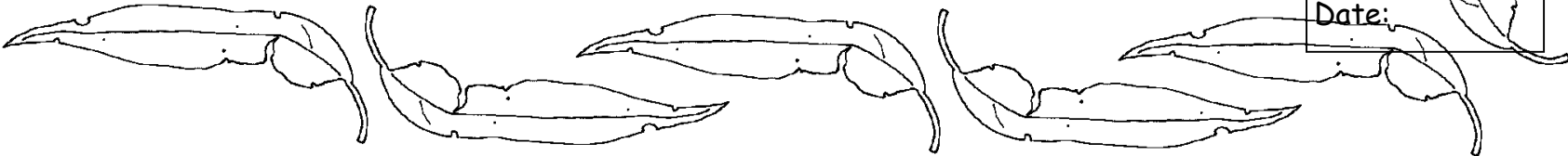
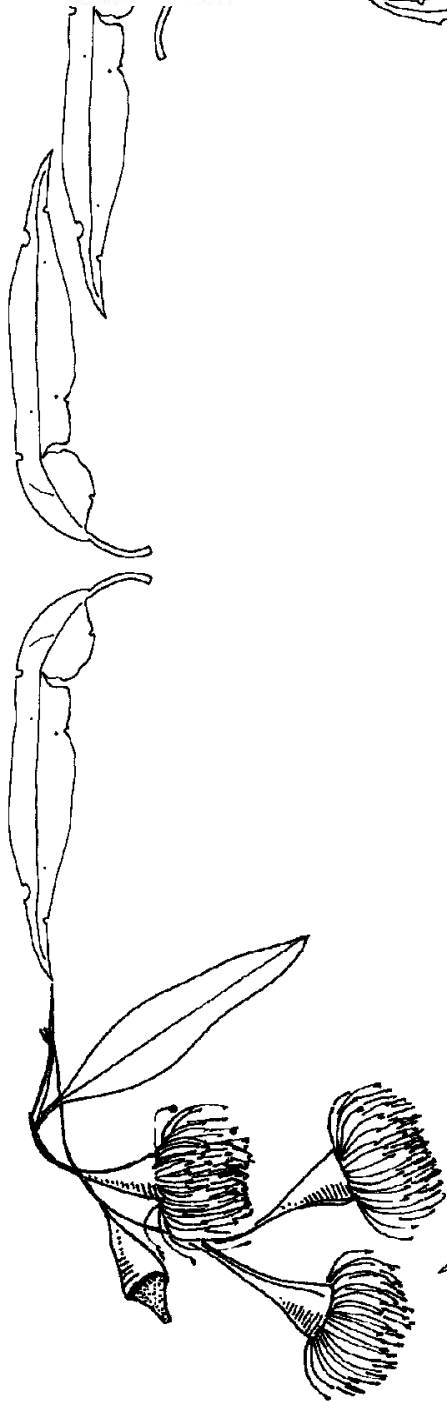
