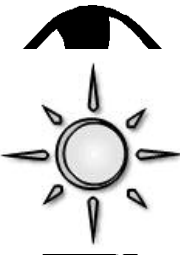
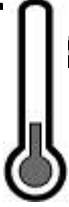
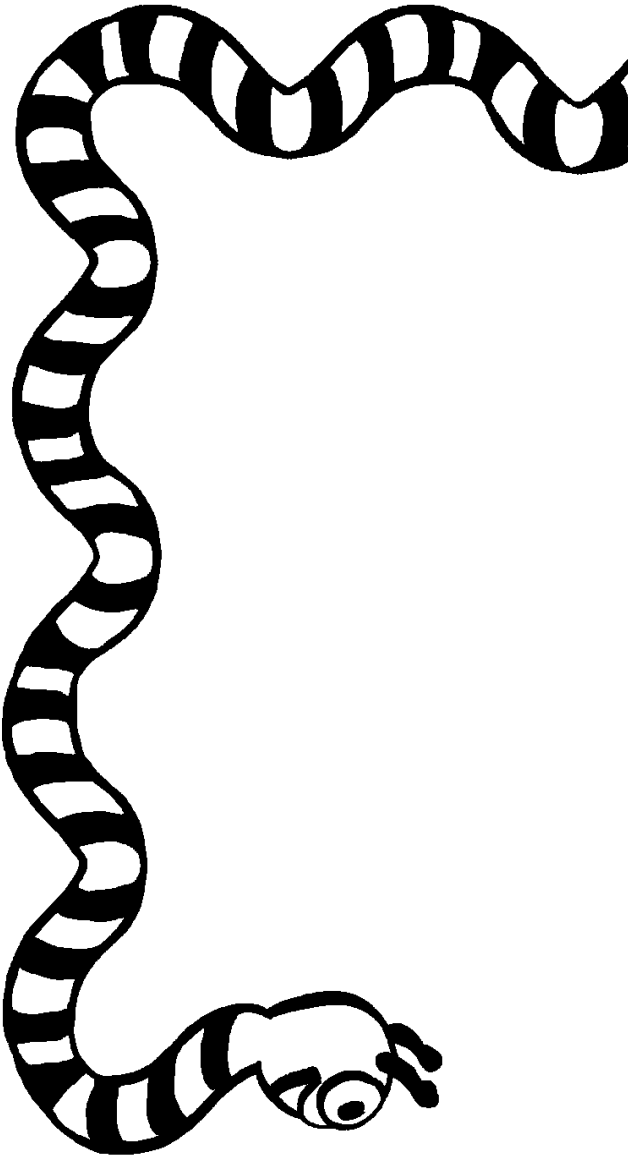
Humpback whale

- 🌸 Bats can be heard at night

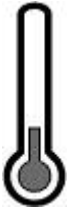
- 🌸 Feral cats have the first of 2 litters
